

Overview

This plan is the result of all the work that has taken place here at All Saints' over the last few months. It started with the LYCIG Local course from which we identified our Mission Priorities. These were shared with the whole congregation over the summer and then formed the basis of the Open Meeting in September. The plan is designed to be:-

Specific

Measurable

Achievable

Relevant

Time-limited

It is also designed to be a living document that changes as we work through it, ever responsive to where God is leading us.

There are two key elements that will help us to achieve our targets:-

(1) We need to be focused, as a Church, on growth. This can be seen in the use every service of the LYCIG prayer, and in our Monday evening Prayer meetings, which are centred on our desire for growth.

(2) We need to have a clear picture of the skills and talents we already have among our worshipping congregation. As 1 Peter 4 verse 10 says, "As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace". We will undertake a skills audit over the next few weeks, so that we have a clear picture of the skills available to us, and the desires to use these skills to further the work of the Church.

We have initially identified three key areas for action:-
